

Kindy Room




Hello Families.

The children in the Kindy room have been really enjoying role playing hairdressers this month. If you have any old hair straighteners or hair dryers you do not use any more they would be greatly received by the children for their play. We are also seeking out any unneeded pots, pans and kitchen utensils that you no longer require. All donations are greatly appreciated. Thank you.



Next to the sign in and out sheet a basket has been created for **children's toys from home to be placed. Please remember to check this basket at the end of the day so your children take their toys home.**

There is also a blue box in the kindy room which has a lot of jumpers and jackets which have been left behind. Please have a look through to see if any belong to your child.



As the weather is getting much warmer we have been having a lot of water play often resulting in the children getting wet. Please be sure to pack a change of clothes in their bag so they can be changed if needed. At the Centre sun safety is extremely important, so as per the centres Hot and Cold Weather Policy, your child is required to wear a top that covers their shoulders while they are playing outside. If your child is toilet training it is also beneficial to pack many articles of clothing should they have a toileting accident.

The Kindy Room Educators are very excited to let you know that our Travelling Pets will be returning in 2018. We offer children the opportunity to take a pet (stuffed animal) home to take care of them for a day or two. This includes a journal to record anything your child would like to share with the other children. Two new pets will be joining us which is very exciting. Children's Christmas Party—Friday 8th December




Thank you for all of the families who were able to attend our Christmas Party.
