Hello Families.

We have been working on our Animal Theme over the last few weeks and you may have seen some pictures of the animals we have been talking and singing about on the wall in our room. The children have used our animal resources and paint and to print foot prints on paper, which we have added to our animal wall. A big thank you to the families who have brought in or emailed through a photo of their family's pet. We have enjoyed seeing and sharing those together during our day. The children have been getting a closer look at our natural environment and the living things we have been finding around our yard. There were a lot of large worms that crawled from our lawn area and on to our verandah, where we picked them up and put them in a small container. The children picked some grass and put some dirt in the bottom and we took turns carrying them around and sharing them with others. We also saw a snail and watched as it slowly moved through the fence and on to the Baby Room's lawn area.

We have made our own play dough and enjoyed adding different materials to it, such as sand and dirt, which completely changes the texture and feel of the dough. Using recycled materials, such as scrap material pieces, cardboard boxes, cereal boxes and paper, the children have used their fine-motor skills to create using glue and paints, discovering different textures on the material pieces and the sticky glue that not only sticks



'everything' to our fingers but for some of us, it tastes good too.

The children have also been building their social and language skills through group activities and have enjoyed climbing and creating obstacle courses together, as they continue to share and learn to take turns throughout most of the activities and experiences.

Please make sure you send your child to care in old clothes that can get dirty and pack a change of clothes or two and gum boots (if your child has any).

We had a visit from Nikki and Bec from Morphett Vale Dental Clinic, who spoke to the children about how to care for our teeth, how to brush our teeth and how long for. They also taught us about the importance of cleaning our tongues and flossing between our teeth to keep our mouths healthy. The children who attended the talk were lucky to take home a 'showbag' with a new toothbrush.

We have started up our 'Travelling Pets' program again. If you would like your child to have the opportunity to bring home the 'Travelling Teddy' please add their name to the list next to the sign in/out sheet. 


